## Architecture: Taj Mahal

Surely you know the Taj Mahal, probably India's most famous building in Agra in the federal state of Uttar Pradesh. But do you also know the moving story behind it?

When Mumtaz Mahal ("jewel of the palace"), the beloved wife of the Great Mogul Shah Jahan died during birth of her 14th child, the Mogul was inconsolable. Shortly after her death in year 1631 he began to build the Taj Mahal, a mausoleum for his great love. Until finishing years passed, more than 20.000 manufacturers from all parts of South- and Central Asia processed the building material which was brought by 1.000 elephants. 28 different kinds of gemstones and semiprecious stones were inserted in the marble. His wife was buried in the subterranean tomb and when he died himself in year 1666, he was buried beside her. Since that time the loving couple is reunited. Today the Taj Mahal is not only the probably most romantic monument in the world, but also one of the most beautiful and important samples of traditional art and has been recorded in the UNESCO World Heritage. With its unique aura it still attracts millions of visitors.







### Personality: Mahatma Gandhi

Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, called Mahatma Gandhi was born in 1869 in India. Initially working as a lawyer, he soon became a fighter for oppressed people all over the world. Though born and raised in a Hindu family, he fought for the conciliation of different religions and said "God has no religion" which became a very famous sentence.

In South Africa he spoke up against apartheid regime. In India, he was the leader of the independence movement against the British rule and fought against the British repression with nonviolent resistance, civil disobedience and hunger strikes. 1947 his efforts were crowned with success and India declared its independence. Famous human rights activists as Martin Luther King and Nelson Mandela were substantially influenced by him.

Nominated 12 times for the Nobel peace prize, his great words will be unforgotten: "Hate can only be overcome by love", "Eye for an eye and the whole world will be blind" and "You must be the change you wish to see in the world". In India he is also called "Bapu" or Father of the Nation.

### Tourism: Goa

It is the smallest federal state in Western India with coastlines stretching along the Arabian sea, an area of ca. 3.700 km² and ca. 1,5 million residents. The Goaparties and the Goamusic (which was originated there) made Goa quickly well-known all over the world. The genre "Goa Trance" is electronic music with a psychedelic character.

Till 1961 it was a Portuguese colony and became very famous with the Hippies after that. Even after the era of the hippies has passed, Goa still today is a popular goal of countless tourists. In addition to its fantastic beaches, it is also known for the tropical spice plantations.

## Movie culture: Bollywood

The term "Bollywood" comes from the name of the city "Bombay" (now Mumbai) and "Hollywood". A successful production should contain all nine *Rasas*, which are the traditional components of India art: love, heroism, bear, humor, fright, wonders, anger, pathos and peace. And as such any hit movie is generally based on a love story, with music, dance, singing, light comedy, action and most importantly happy ending.

It is more formally referred to as Hindi cinema. Though it is only a part of the larger Indian film industry, but revenue wise it is the largest film producer in India. Furthermore it is one of the biggest film industries worldwide in terms of films produce and the number of people employed.

Meanwhile Bollywood-movies are famous all over the world. Amidst all the glamour and dazzle of Hollywood, people miss out on the fact that Bollywood sells 3 times the number of tickets as that of Hollywood!

## Religion / River: Ganges

Ganges, also named "River of redemption" is the third largest river in the world by discharge. Though the river "Brahmaputra" is the largest in length in India, yet "Ganges" remains spiritually the most significant. It has its source in Himalaya and crosses many states and Bangladesh, before finally merging in the Indian Ocean. It is the holiest river for hindus. Indian people call their river "Ganga Mata", mother Ganga, the goddess that became a river. The water is attributed to have the power to purge the sins. It is believed to contain an elixir of immortality which helps in healing the diseases. They say that bottled Ganges-water never spoils. The Ganges permanently is the destination of thousands of pilgrims and visitors to take a ritual bath and perform holy ceremonies.

## Wild life: elephants and tigers

India is famously known for its elephants and tigers. In addition it has an amazingly wide spectrum of animals native to the country and is home to rare & threatened animal species.

The Bengal- or Indian Tiger which weighs up to 300 kgs, living in the jungle and tropical areas, is by now threatened by extinction. Therefore shooting of tigers is officially prohibited in India since 1970.

The Indian elephants (officially: "Asian elephants") differ from African elephants by their smaller mould and smaller ears. Domestication of elephants has been documented already thousands of years ago in India. They have always been used for traction and as working animals, e.g. for movement of heavy weights. Meanwhile also the powerful pachyderms are under wildlife conservation, as their number was heavily reduced by overhunting for ivory.

While most of the over 50 Mars missions of all nations failed, India became the first nation in Asia that reached the Red Planet. In addition, water-oxygen compounds on the moon were first reported in 2007 by "Chandrayaan-1", a space probe of ISRO.

Tirumala Tirupati temple is considered as one of the oldest and holiest Hindu pilgrimage sites. The temple is visited by about 40 million people annually, making it the most visited holy site in the world, even more than Mecca. It is also the richest temple in the world in terms of donations received and wealth.

The game "Snakes and Ladders" also originated in India. Under the name "Moksha Patamu", the game plan was a symbol of the life that must be mastered. By increasing the virtues and sinking the vices, one could attain Nirvana, was the original message. Though the game is known and played internationally, without many knowing the symbolic character.

Guru (Sanskrit: teacher) is not just a religious title for a spiritual teacher. In India, for example, the first guru in life is one's own father or mother. "Guru" literally means "who removes the dark". Today, this word has been adopted in many languages other than English and is used to define a person who is a master of his subject. Image: H. H. Sri Sri Ravi Shankar, founder of Art of Living, a guru of international fame.

"Kumbh Mela" is considered to be the largest religious festival of Hinduism and the largest peaceful gathering in the history of the world taking place at 4 different locations (Haridwar, Allahabad, Nashik and Ujjain) by rotation. People gather to bathe in a holy river which is thought to cleanse a person of all sins. For Hindus, the Kumbh Mela is the holiest of all pilgrimages. During the 60 days that the Kumbh Mela lasts, about 100 million people visit the venue.
